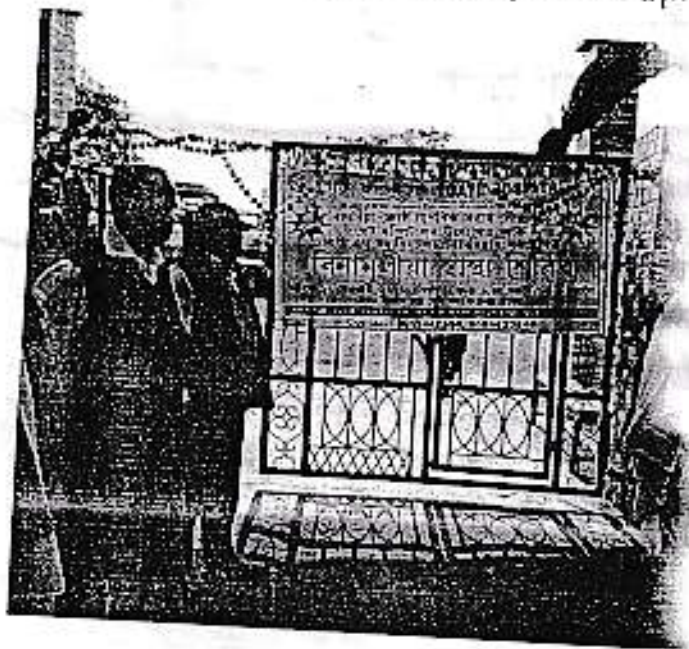
## FREE HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP

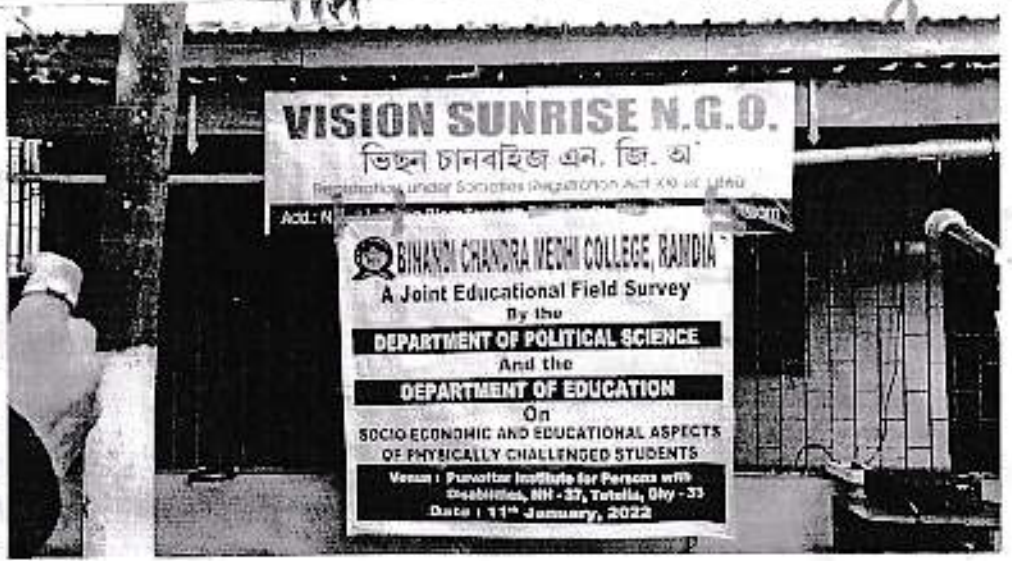


