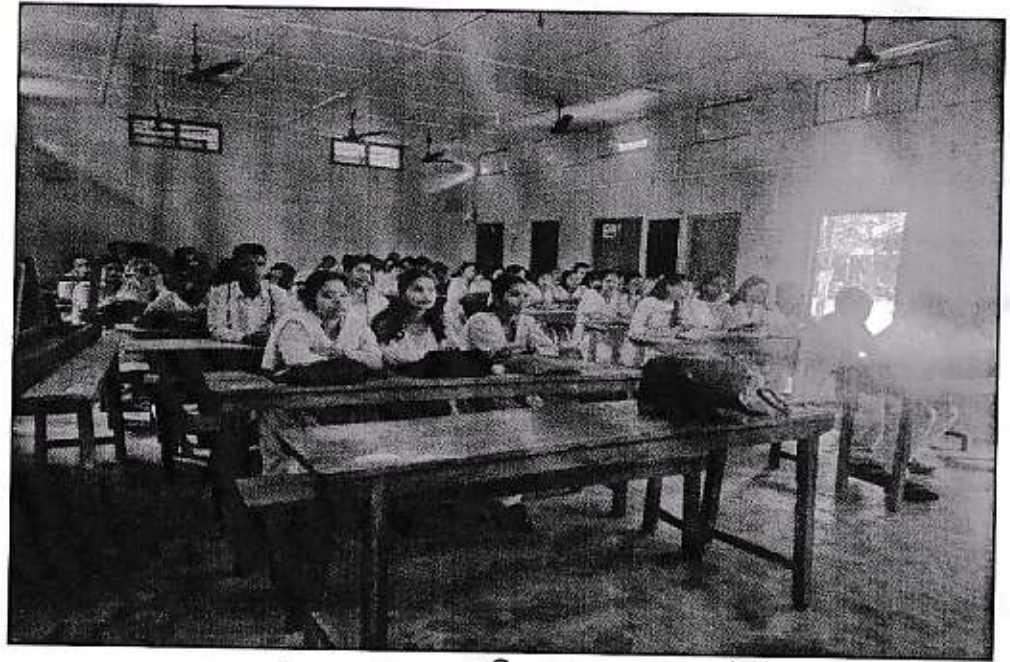

## Extension Programme Report 2021

Programme Name: Educational and Economic Survey  
on Molidapara Village.

In 2021, December 20: The Dept of Education, B. C. Medhi College, Romdia had organized a programme on Educational and Economic aspects of Molidapara Village. <sup>Chukuri</sup> The survey was done with the students of B.A. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester of Education, Regular course. The programme was started at 12. a.m. from the college campus to the surveyed village. In the beginning of the programme, the Gaonbuda of Molidapara village was facilitated by Education Department in the college premises in the presence of Dr. Ashit Kr. Paul, principal i/c, Teachers, Non-teaching staff and the students of the college. After a brief explanation about the objectives of the programme, the Head of Education Department Dr. Bijuli Dura, the Principal i/c, Gaonbuda, Office assistant Roman Medhi, faculties of Education Dept and the students of B.A. 6<sup>th</sup> Semester (RC) went to four houses of the village and thus started the programme. A total of 60 students along with principal i/c, teachers, Gaonbuda and office assistant four houses were surveyed as sample. The students were taught the technique of survey using this sample survey. After that the students were allowed to collect data and asked to submit the questionnaires to the Head of the department. The students completed their tasks very obediently and back down the questionnaires in the same day to HOD.



## Findings of the survey:

From the survey, the students find out —

1. The total population of the village Chelchuri is  
= 329 Male: 172 Female: 157

2. The educational status of the villagers are

a. H.S.L.C. passed 61%.

b. H.S. passed 34%.

c. B.A. passed 4.2%.

d. M.A. passed 1.1%.

3. The economic status of the villagers are sound

Most of them earn their livelihood through business.

12% are servicemen.

The survey was an interesting one. Students learn about survey process. They also come to know about total 81 families of the Chelchuri (Malidapar).

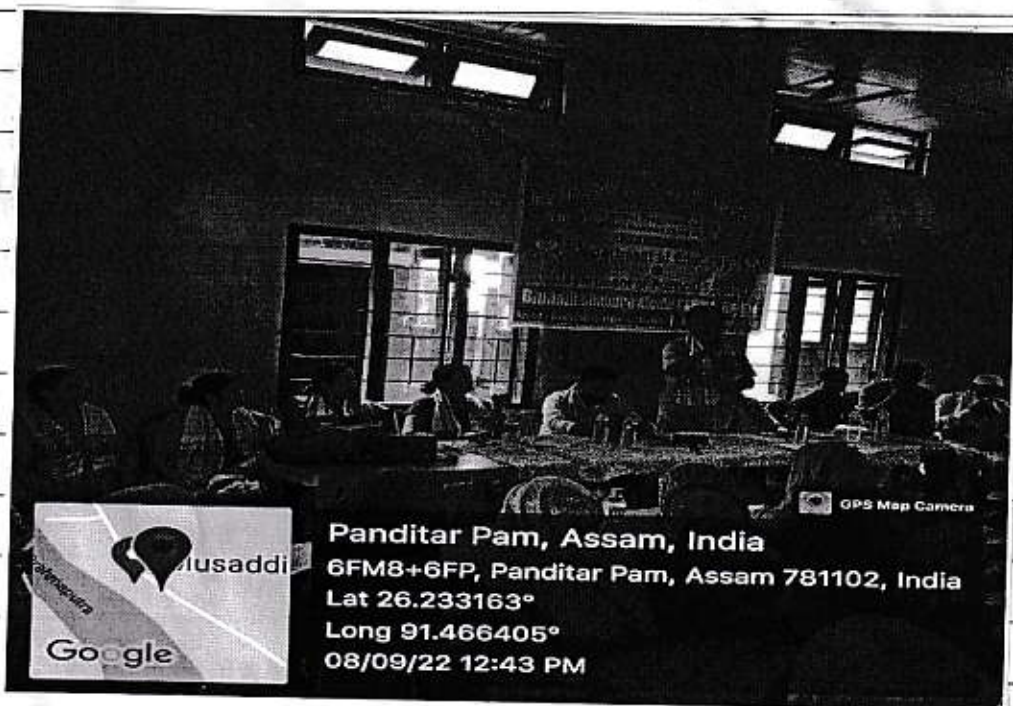
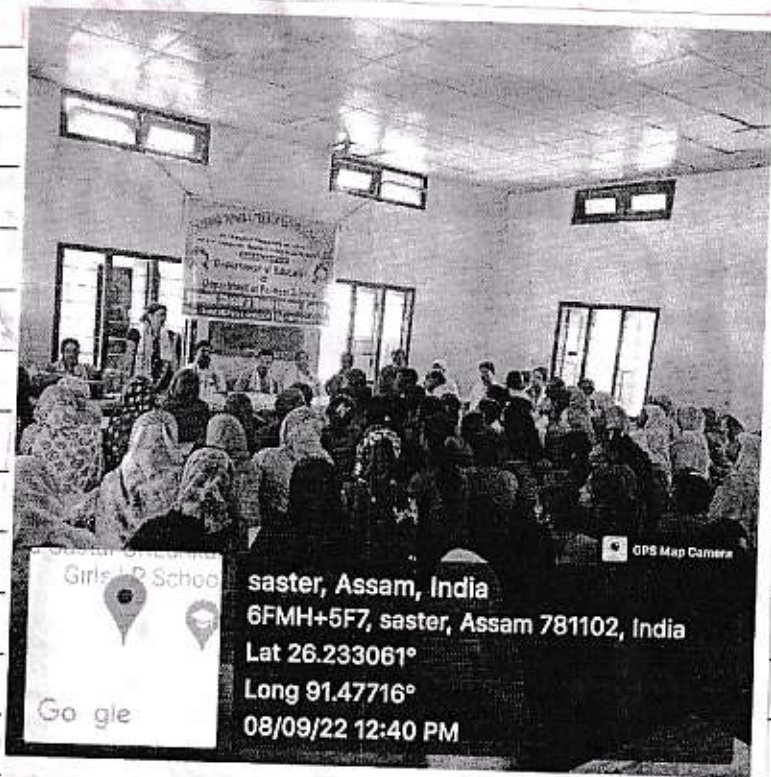
