Applicability for Fee Waiver Scheme

- 1. Students whose Parental Annual Income is less than Rs. 2 lakhs from all sources will be eligible to avail this scheme.
- 2. If either of the parent (Father or Mother) of the student is working in State Govt/ Central Govt./ Semi Govt. State or Central Govt. undertaking, will not be eligible for free admission.
- 3. Students have to submit an Income Certificate from competent authority i.e. Notary/Head of the institution from where the student has passed out.
- 4. Students have to submit a declaration form that neither of the parents (Father or Mother) of the student is an employee of the State, Central Govt. Department or its undertaking,
- 5. Student has to **plant a sapling** at his/her college or his/her home and shall give photograph of the same to the college. They have to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission into 2nd, 3rd and 4th year shall have to give the photograph of the same tree which was planted during the previous year.
