A Report

A workshop on PREPARATION OF ECO FRIENDLY HOLI COLOURS was organized by ECO club, B.C.Medhi College, Ramdia under Environment Education Programme (EEP), Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) on 02-03-2026. The registration of students and Teachers of the college started at 9.30 a.m. and the inaugural session at 10.00 a.m. In this session Dr. Biswajit Das graced the occasion as chairman and Mr. Atul chandra kakati, eminent social worker lightened the inaugural lamp of the workshop. He expressed the feelings of organising such a time relevant workshop for students and teachers for making eco-friendly holi colours. The workshop was also graced by Jharna Kalita, Resource person (Eminent Holi maker), Jayshree Baman, Resource person, Mr.Dilip Das, guest of honour and Dr. Abdul Mazid Ahmed. They were felicitated by Fulam Gamosa, Japi and Mementos. The welcome address was delivered by Dr.Biswajit Das. He welcomed the Resource Persons (RPs), Guest of Honour and all the participants to the workshop. The programme was anchored by Dr. Satyabati Medhi and she also stated the purpose of the programme.

In the first session, Jharna Kalita explained the harmful effect of using holi colours available in market because of using chemical like Manganese, lead oxide, acids, talc, silica, copper sulfate, etc. in holi colours. As she explained that these colours cause various skin disease, eye infection, cardiovascular problems and other health problems. She displayed various raw materials used for preparation of holi colours like beet root, carrot, spinach, neem leaf, turmeric flour, corn flour etc. which are endowed locally and beneficial for our skin. In the second session, complete hands on practice was given how to prepare holi colours from flour and beetroot, turmeric and gram flour, neem leaf, carrot, spinach and marigold flower. Around seventy students and fifteen teachers joined in the workshop and prepared various eco-friendly holi colours under the guidance of Jharna kalita. They used grinder machines, bamboo xorahi and dala to grind and drying of colours. Finally, it was around

four kilograms of holi colours produced and it was shared among students and teachers for forthcoming holi festival. It was quite a fruitful session for all of us to learn.

In the third and fourth session Jayshree Barman very nicely demonstrated the steps of making of rongolis, face painting and colourful paintings. From participants' side very positive response received as they will take eco-friendly holi producing as a profession in future for self-reliance. During the programme light refreshment was offered to participants. In the concluding time chairperson delivered short speech on importance of holi colours and offered thanks to ASTEC for offering such a fruitful workshop. Amidst the workshop Dr. Bishnu Ram Das performed a Holi Song to create holi vive in the workshop. In the programme, Dr. Mukut Pathak, Ramen Das, Akhil pathak, Jesmine Choudhury, Abu lais, Abdul Rezak, Nazrul Islam participated actively in the workshop. The certificates were distributed among participants and Joya Medhi offered vote of thanks.

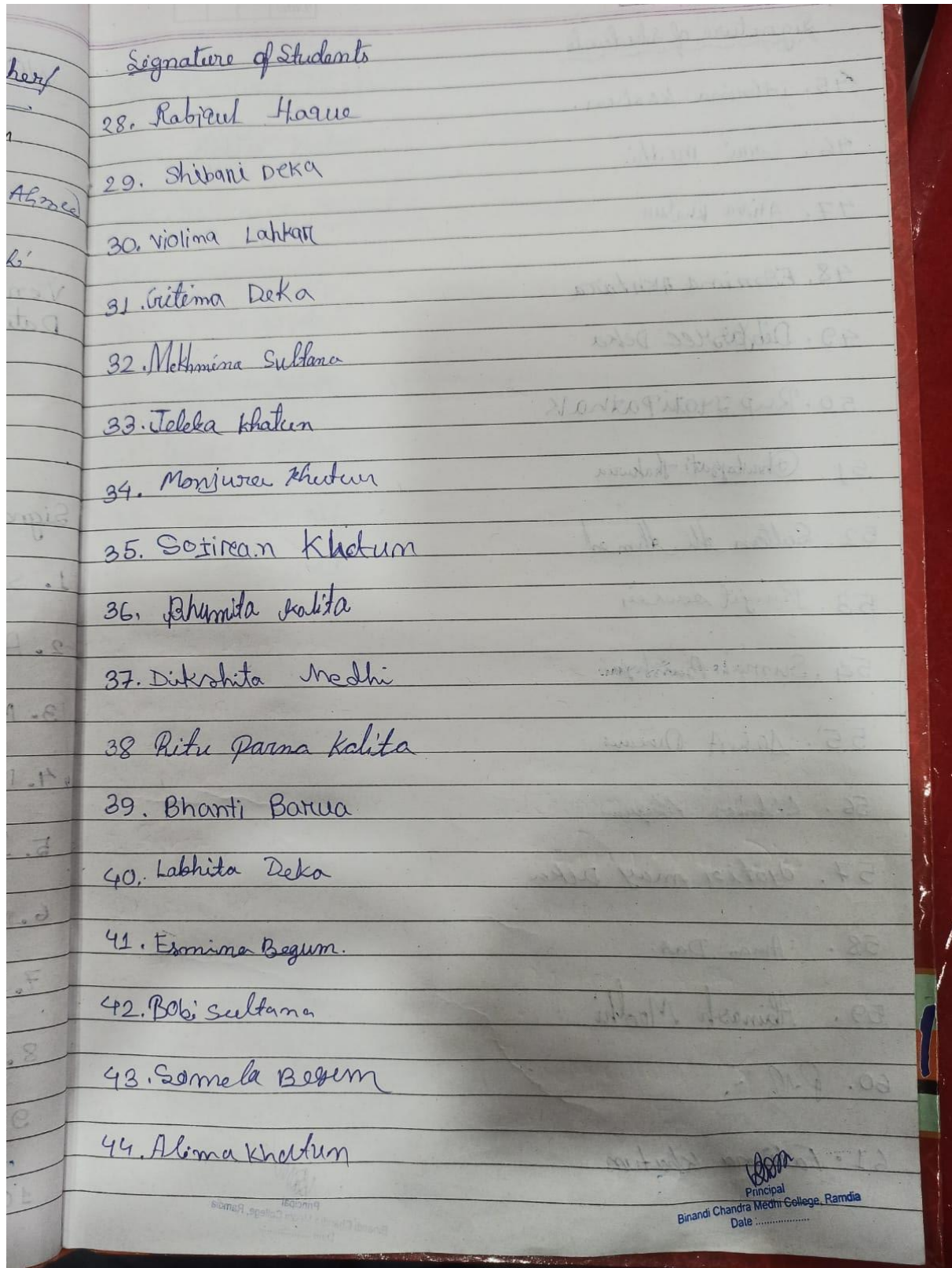
