

Report On Awareness Programme- Day against **Superstitious Beliefs**

Medhi College, Ramdia organizes an awareness programme against superstition today (on 13th May, 2025) on the first death anniversary of Birubala Rabha, a great and bold fighter against superstition throughout her life. The meeting is held at ICT room of the college at 11:00 a.m. The meeting is presided over by the principal of the college Dr. Biswajit Das. The objective of the meeting and the welcome speech is delivered by Dilip Das, programme officer of college NSS Cell. Two invited speakers respectively Dr. Meena Kumari Das, HoD of Assamese department and Dr. Satyabati Medhi, HoD of Economics department deliver their valuable speech. Dr. Meena Kumari Das focuses briefly on Birubala Rabha's life and activities as well as on the four pillars of culture. Dr. Satyabati Medhi defines 'superstition' and Birubala Rabha's mission against witch hunting and other superstitious faith. She explains elaborately the two types of superstitions. She further states that superstitions run mostly in tribal communities; mentions the countries in which it runs mostly. She further states that superstition can hamper in the progress of human community. Some measures against superstitions are also stated by the respected speaker. Dr. Lalit Chandra Bharali and Jitendra Deka also delivers lecture on the topic from the staff. Sanidul Hashan, a student of the college delivers his speech from students' side; he sings a Goalporia song also. Dr. Mukut Pathak, Asst.
