- (ii) A Ph.D. degree in concerned/allied/relevant discipline (s) in the institutions concerned with evidence of published work.
- (iii) Associate Professor/ Professor with a total experience of 15 (fifteen) years of Teaching/ research/administration in university/colleges and other institutions of higher education.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal in Appendix-III for Direct recruitment of Professors in colleges.
- (v) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Schedule Tribe/ Differently Abled (Physically and Visually differently abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale (where ever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace marks procedures.
- (vi) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D holders, who have obtained their Master's Degrees prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991.
- (vii) Upper age limit of 55 years as per prescribed Rules.
- (viii) A minimum of 10 research publications in peer reviewed or UGC listed journals.
- (ix) A minimum of 110 Research Scores as per Appendix-II at Table 2.
- (x) The term of principal shall be 5 (five) years as per guidelines of Govt. of Assam.



**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Guidelines for Selection of Principals in Provincialised Colleges of Assam.**

In cancellation of all previous Govt. OMs, the Government of Assam in Higher Education Department is pleased to notify the following guidelines for selection of Principals in Provincialised Colleges of Assam.

- (i) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale whenever grading system is followed) by a recognised University.
- (ii) A Ph.D Degree in concerned/allied/relevant discipline(s) in the institutions concerned with evidence of published work.
- (iii) Associate Professor/Professor with a total experience of fifteen years of teaching/research/Administration in University/Colleges and other institutions of Higher Education.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on Performance Based Appraisal in Appendix III for direct recruitment of Professors in Colleges.
- (v) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Schedule Tribe/Differently abled (Physically and visually differently abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- (vi) A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degrees prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991.
- (vii) Upper age limit of 55 years as per prescribed Rules.

Now the UGC vide regulation dated 18-07-2018 has modified the eligibility criteria for the post of Principals of Provincialised Colleges as shown below :

- (i) Ph.D Degree.
- (ii) Professor/Associate Professor with a total service/experience of at least fifteen years of teaching/research in Universities, Colleges and other institutions of Higher Education.
- (iii) A minimum of 10 research publications in peer reviewed or UGC listed journals.
- (iv) A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix II at Table-2.

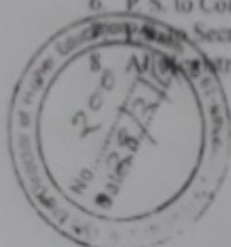
